W13 **Calabria Family Wines “Little Stones”** 13

Chardonnay, South Eastern Australia

Unoaked crisp style Chardonnay, displays upfront aromatics of stone fruits and peach blossom. The palate is refreshing and flavourful. Displaying characters of tropical fruit.

W14 **Calabria Family Wines “Okiwi Bay”** 14

Sauvignon Blanc, South Eastern Australia

Very pale yellow-gold in appearance with green hues. An intensely aromatic wine with a fragrance of gooseberry, nectarine, and grapefruit; the vibrant palate is rich with a deliciously dry finish, due to the typical Marlborough acidity.

W9 **Te Mata Estate, 2023** 19

Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand

Bright and lively; perfect with Tom Yum soup or spicy salads thanks to its citrus zip.

<i>Sauvignon Blanc</i>
This Touraine Sauvignon Blanc is crisp and refreshing, with rich, ripe lime and grapefruit aromas Great elegance with mineral style and despite everything some kind of roundness. | 90 |

- W7 **Casteltonne Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, Veneto, Italy** 85
Pinot Grigio
This Pinot Grigio has clean smooth flavours and subtle mineral character. The nose is pure and clean, but the palate speaks expressively with tangy citrus flavours and ripe orchard fruits, like red delicious apples.

- W8 **Goldwater Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough** 95
Sauvignon Blanc
Intensely aromatic with stone fruit and subtle citrus notes. Rich, ripe flavours.
- W9 **Te Mata Estate, 2023** 95
Sauvignon Blanc
Bright and lively; perfect with Tom Yum soup or spicy salads thanks to its citrus zips.

USA

- W10 **Butterfield Station, California** 100
Chardonnay
The California Chardonnay with aromas of baked apple, fresh Asian pear, and creamy vanilla. With a round mouthfeel, the palate is layered with flavours of rich butterscotch, ginger, and baking spices.

W11 **Sierra Cantabria Crianza, Rioja, Spain** 110

Sauvignon Blanc

It is an aromatic white wine blend of Viura, Malvasia and Sauvignon Blanc, with an elegant nose of fresh white fruit accompanied by fragrant floral notes. On the palate it is enveloping, fresh and well-balanced finish.

W12 **Marqués de Murrieta Pazo Barrantes, 2021** 178

Albariño

Vibrant and saline; pairs beautifully with spicy crab or fried fish with herbs.

W13 **Calabria Family Wines “Little Stones”** 65

Chardonnay, South Eastern Australia

Unoaked crisp style Chardonnay, displays upfront aromatics of stone fruits and peach blossom. The palate is refreshing and flavourful. Displaying characters of tropical fruit.

W14 **Calabria Family Wines “Okiwi Bay”** 70

Sauvignon Blanc, South Eastern Australia

Very pale yellow-gold in appearance with green hues. An intensely aromatic wine with a fragrance of gooseberry, nectarine, and grapefruit; the vibrant palate is rich with a deliciously dry finish, due to the typical Marlborough acidity.

W15 **Juniper Estate Three Fields, Margaret River** 105

Chardonnay

Bright, pale straw. Tropical fruits, melon citrus and apple aromas feature on the nose with gentle spice tones and integrated oak. The fruit profile is powerful yet controlled, oak beautifully balanced, the acidity bracing with a saline mineral quality. Refreshing, delicious, and long finish.

R1	Cave de Lugny, Pinot Noir La Cote Blanc, Burgundy <i>Pinot Noir</i> This Burgundy Pinot Noir offers a range of aromas of small red fruits and licorice. It is characterized by a rich palette of aromas of red fruits and spices, with a supple structure and a very fresh finish. It can accompany many dishes.	115
R2	Faiveley Mercurey Vieilles Vignes, 2023 <i>Pinot Noir</i> Silky Pinot Noir; works with pork satay or herbal sausage.	118
R3	Chateau Lyonnat, Lussac Saint Emilion, Bordeaux <i>Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon</i> Medium to full bodied, with depth, structure, well integrated oak, and a certain elegance that contrasts with the power of the wine, this strikes an excellent balance between fruit and tannin and a long finish.	125
R4	Domaine du Pere Caboché Chateauneuf-du-Pape Rouge <i>Grenache, Syrah</i> The colour is bright and deep ruby red with bluish highlights. The nose is intense with full aromas of ripe red fruits, mineral (schist) and smoky hints on soft spices. This full-bodied wine has a nice balance between sweetness and a fine tannic structure. The fruity and peppery flavours dominate on licorice and Espelette pepper finish.	155
R5	Chateau Boutisse, St. Émilion Grand Cru, Right Bank <i>Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon</i> A warm, intense bouquet of mocha and sweet spices. The palate is classic from a great estate in Saint Emilion showing fullbody, fine yet firm tannins, explosive black cherry fruit, all encased in the subtle vanilla flavour of new oak.	165
R6	Château Bourgneuf Pomerol, 2020 <i>Merlot</i> Merlot-based richness; perfect with beef curry or stir-fried beef with basil.	178

- R7 **Palazzo Rosso di Montalcino, Tuscany** 130
Sangiovese
It has a fruity perfume, rich, intense and persistent. Its great structure does not in the least diminish the freshness of the wine, which is ready to be enjoyed.
- R8 **Lanciola Chianti Classico Riserva, Tuscany** 135
Sangiovese
Aromas of black-skinned berry, cedar and cooking spice emerge from the glass. This classico Sangiovese with round palate offers clove, ripe blackberry and star anise alongside pliant tannins.
- R9 **Ellena Giuseppe Barolo di La Morra, Piedmont** 145
Nebbiolo
Bright red fruit with tinges of violets, tobacco and citrus rind. Medium-bodied with lightly chewy tannins, bright acidity and more orange rind and a twist of nutty vanilla right at the end.

- R10 **Te Mata Estate Gamay Noir 2023** 95
Pinot Noir
Light, juicy, and chillable; excellent with spicy minced meat salad or grilled chicken.
- R11 **Te Mata Estate Coleraine 2022** 270
Cabernet Sauvignon
Structured Bordeaux blend; ideal for slow-cooked beef short rib curry.

USA

- R12 **Joel Gott Zinfandel, California** 115
Zinfandel
Sycamore Lane Cabernet Sauvignon displays aroma of fresh red cherries and sweet oak vanilla with hint of herbal tones. The medium-bodied, juicy, cherry-like flavours are supported and enhanced moderate tannins and a toasty wood character.
- R13 **Napa Cellars, Napa Valley, California** 135
Merlot
This is an explosive Merlot wine offering of succulent black cherry and cola that finds balance and backbone on the structured mid palate. It finishes with hints of clove, cedar and toasted oak that linger.

- R14 **Marqués de Murrieta Reserva, 2021** 108
Tempranillo
Elegant Rioja; smooth with red curry duck or massaman curry.
- R15 **Sierra Cantabria Crianza, Rioja** 130
Tempranillo
With a bouquet of dark plums, herbes de Provence and tobacco leaf, this Tempranillo wine has flavours of blackberry, black currant, butterscotch, anise and thyme, with downy tannins and a bright, pomegranate-splashed finish.

- R16 **Calabria Family Wines “Bulletin Place”** 65
Cabernet Sauvignon, South Eastern Australia
This Cabernet Sauvignon is showcasing the essential traits of Australia, it is an attractive fruit-driven red. Full bouquet of fresh berries complemented by subtle French oak. Ripe plum characters flow smoothly onto the palate, integrated spice, and vanilla oak.
- R17 **Juniper Estate Three Fields, Margaret River** 105
Cabernet Sauvignon
A fresh, fruit-focused cabernet with ripe raspberries and red cherries, as well as blackcurrant and lightly leafy tones. The palate is driven by bright and intense fruit with oak adding some extra spicy depth and weight. Agile and drinkable cabernet.
- R18 **Lake Cooper Heathcote, Victoria** 115
Shiraz
Dark crimson, hues of purple and ruby. Bright and perfumed aromas of red forest fruits and subtle toasty French oak. The palate is densely layered and effortlessly long, combining texture and richness.
